

StarCLS, Inc. **Data Privacy Addendum**

This Data Privacy Addendum (“**DPA**”) forms part of the Service Agreement or Terms of Service (the “**Agreement**”) between **StarCLS, Inc.** (d/b/a “StarQuiz”) and the educational institution, school district, or school identified in the Agreement (“**District**”).

1. Definitions

- “**Authorized User**” means a student, teacher, or staff member authorized by the District to access the Service.
- “**Data Privacy Laws**” means applicable laws relating to privacy and data protection, including **FERPA** (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act), **COPPA** (Children’s Online Privacy Protection Act), **CCPA** (California Consumer Privacy Act), and applicable state student data privacy laws (e.g., SOPIPA).
- “**Student Data**” means any personally identifiable information (PII) or material, in any media or format, that is personally identifiable to a student and is provided by the District or its Users to StarQuiz.
- “**Security Breach**” means any accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure of, or access to Student Data.

2. Compliance and Roles

2.1 School Official Status. Under FERPA, StarQuiz is acting as a “**School Official**” with a legitimate educational interest in the Student Data. StarQuiz agrees to remain under the direct control of the District with respect to the use and maintenance of Student Data.

2.2 Data Processor. Under applicable privacy laws, the District is the **Data Controller** (owner) and StarQuiz is the **Data Processor** (service provider). StarQuiz will process Student Data solely to provide the Services defined in the Agreement.

3. Data Privacy Commitments

To ensure clarity and trust, StarQuiz makes the following commitments regarding its processing of Student Data:

3.1 What We Do With Data

- **Educational Use Only:** We use Student Data solely to provide and improve educational services.
- **Security:** We store data using industry-standard encryption (at rest and in transit).
- **District Control:** We acknowledge that the District retains ownership and control of all Student Data.
- **Compliance:** We comply with FERPA, COPPA, and applicable state regulations.
- **Rights Requests:** We provide tools and support to allow Districts to access, export, or delete data upon request.

3.2 What We Do NOT Do

- **No Selling:** We do not sell, rent, or trade Student Data.
- **No Targeted Advertising:** We do not use Student Data for behavioral targeting of advertisements to students.
- **No Non-Educational Profiling:** We do not build behavioral profiles of students other than for supporting the educational purpose.
- **No General AI Training:** We do not use Student Data to train general, non-educational public AI models.

4. Security and Breach Notification

4.1 Security Measures. StarQuiz shall implement and maintain appropriate administrative, technical, and physical security measures to protect Student Data from unauthorized access, disclosure, or misuse.

4.2 Breach Notification. In the event of a Security Breach, StarQuiz shall notify the District within 72 hours of discovery, or as required by applicable state law (whichever is sooner). StarQuiz will make reasonable efforts to provide notification as soon as practicable after becoming aware of the breach.

- **Content of Notice:** The notice shall include, to the extent known: (a) the nature of the breach; (b) the types of data involved; (c) the steps StarQuiz is taking to investigate and mitigate the breach; and (d) contact information for further inquiry.

5. Subprocessors

5.1 Authorized Subprocessors. The District acknowledges and agrees that StarQuiz may use the third-party subprocessors listed in **Exhibit A** (or the current "Subprocessor List" maintained in the Trust Center) to process Student Data.

5.2 Right to Object. StarQuiz will provide the District with notice (via email or platform update) of any **new** subprocessor before authorizing them to process Student Data.

- The District has the right to object to a new subprocessor on reasonable data protection grounds within **thirty (30) days** of notice.
- If the parties cannot resolve the objection, the District may terminate the Agreement with respect to those services that require the new subprocessor.

6. Data Rights and Deletion

6.1 Access and Correction. StarQuiz will assist the District in fulfilling its obligations to respond to requests from parents or eligible students to inspect, review, or correct Student Data.

6.2 Deletion upon Termination. Upon termination of the Agreement or upon the District's written request, StarQuiz shall **securely destroy** or return all Student Data in its possession, unless required by law to retain it. Certification of deletion will be provided upon request.

7. Change of Control and Business Continuity

7.1 Merger, Acquisition, or Change of Control. In the event of a merger, acquisition, sale of assets, or other change in control of StarQuiz, all rights and obligations regarding Student Data under this DPA shall transfer to and be binding upon the successor entity. The District's ownership and control rights over Student Data, as set forth in Section 2.2 and Section 3.1, shall be preserved and continue in full force and effect.

7.2 Bankruptcy or Insolvency. In the event of StarQuiz's bankruptcy, insolvency, or similar proceeding: (a) Student Data shall remain the property of the District; (b) The District shall have the right to retrieve or require deletion of all Student Data; (c) Student Data shall not be considered an asset of StarQuiz's estate; and (d) Any successor entity or trustee shall be bound by the obligations set forth in this DPA.

7.3 Notice Requirements. StarQuiz shall provide the District with at least thirty (30) days' written notice prior to any change of control event, including the identity of the successor entity and confirmation that the successor entity will be bound by this DPA.

8. General Provisions

8.1 Supremacy. In the event of a conflict between this DPA and the main Service Agreement, the terms of this DPA shall control regarding the processing of Student Data.

8.2 Governing Law. This DPA shall be governed by the laws of the jurisdiction specified in the main Agreement (Delaware), unless a specific state student privacy law mandates the laws of the District's state.
